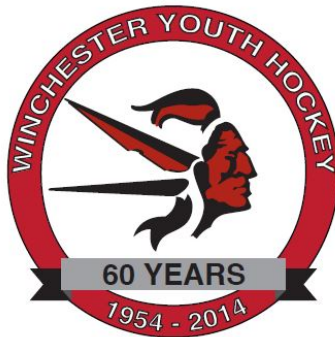


Tuition Assistance

Winchester Youth Hockey offers two forms of tuition assistance. First, we offer multi-child discounts for families with more than one child in the program, however, there are some exceptions. Child #2 generally receives a 10% discount and all additional children receive a 50% discount. The exceptions are: half-season Midget and Girls U18 programs, full time goalie tuitions and supplementary programs (when offered) are not discountable. If you have a child in one of these non-full season programs they are not counted when we calculate the family discount. For example, if a family has a child in the half-season Midget program, and a daughter in the full-season Girls-Only Travel program and a third child in our full-season Youth Travel program, the Midget player is ignored and the family has two tuitions which are considered eligible for the family discount. The lower priced one (in this example) will be discounted 10%. Second, Winchester Youth Hockey also offers tuition scholarships to needy families, whose children would not otherwise be able to participate. Scholarship discussions are held on a confidential basis between the family and our President and/or Treasurer. Winchester Youth Hockey does not require any financial documentation, but we simply ask that scholarship discussions be based on honestly articulated need. Most scholarships are structured with partial assistance, as we hope that most families receiving assistance will contribute in some way to their family's tuition.
