PLAYER

1. No swearing, abusive language or vulgar gestures will be tolerated on the bench, on the ice, in the rink, or at any team function.
2. No verbal or physical lashing out at any official, opposing coach or player. The WYH coaching staff will communicate with game officials to address all matters pertaining to officiating and/or scorekeeping.
3. Players who are penalized will skate directly to the penalty box and refrain from arguing about the penalty with the officials.
4. Fighting will not be tolerated and may result in a suspension consistent with USA Hockey and league rules.
5. There will be no drinking of alcohol, tobacco use, or use of illegal substances at any WYH team event.
6. I will conduct myself in a befitting and respectful manner at all facilities (ice rink, hotel, restaurant, etc.) during any WYH team function.
7. I understand that any failure to abide by this code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action by WYH

PARENT

The game will be stopped by on-ice officials when the parents/spectators displaying inappropriate and disruptive behavior interfere with other spectators or the game. The on-ice officials will identify violators to the coaches for the purpose of removing parents/spectators from the spectator's viewing and game area. Once removed, play will resume. Lost time will not be replaced and violators may be subject to further disciplinary action by the local governing body. This inappropriate and disruptive behavior shall include:

1. Use of obscene or vulgar language in a boisterous manner to anyone at any time.
2. Taunting of players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, threat of violence or physical violence.
3. Throwing of any object in the spectator's viewing area, player's bench, penalty box or on-ice surface, directed in any manner as to create a safety hazard.

I understand that any failure to abide by this code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action by WYH.
