

Tuition Assistance

Winchester Youth Hockey offers two forms of tuition assistance. First, we offer multi-child discounts for families with more than one child in the program, however, there are some exceptions. Child #2 generally receives a 10% discount and all additional children receive a 50% discount. The exceptions are: half season Midget/Girls programs, full time goalie tuitions and supplementary programs (such as our Girls Valley League team) are not discountable. If you have a child in one of these programs they are not counted when we calculate the family discount. For example, if you have one son in Boys Midgets, a daughter in Girls-Only Travel (full season) and a son in Boys/Open Travel the Midget son is ignored and you have two tuitions which are considered eligible for the family discount. The lower priced one (in this example) will be discounted 10%.

Second, Winchester Youth Hockey offers tuition scholarships to needy families, whose children would not otherwise be able to participate in Winchester Youth Hockey. Scholarship discussions are held on a confidential basis between the family and our President and/or Treasurer. Winchester Youth Hockey does not require any financial documentation, but we simply ask that scholarship discussions be based on honest need. Most scholarships are partial assistance, as we hope that most families receiving assistance will contribute in some way to their family's tuition.
